



Coleraine College Years 9-12 admissions criteria

1. Children with record of acceptable behaviour towards staff and pupils, who have a positive attitude towards their studies and whose attendance at the time of application is above 85%. (See note 1)
2. Children for whom the curriculum provides appropriate provision (see Note 2)
3. Pupils who have a sibling currently attending the school (See Note 3).
4. Children who are classed as “Looked After Children”
5. Children who are entitled to free school meals.
6. Pupils for whom this is their nearest secondary school (See Note 4).

Note 1: Governors reserve the right to determine what constitutes acceptable behaviour and the right to make exceptions in individual cases, especially regarding attendance.

Note 2: For pupils wishing to transfer during Years 11 and 12, there must be a suitable match for the subjects they are already studying.

Note 3: Reference to sibling includes brother/sister, half/step/long-term foster brother/sister /adopted brother/sister..

Note 4: Reference to distance will be measured as the crow flies on an ordnance survey map from the home to the main front gate of the school.
